This is a summary of the decision of the DPC

The Data Protection Office received an official complaint submitted manually by the Complainant. The complaint was lodged against his neighbour (the Respondent) regarding the installation and use of CCTV cameras. The Complainant alleged that the Respondent had installed surveillance cameras directly into his premises, thereby intruding on his privacy.

Subsequently, the Data Protection Office wrote to the Police to seek assistance for investigating this complaint and to conduct a site visit at the Respondent's premises.

The Police conducted the site visit and confirmed that no evidence was found to substantiate the Complainant's allegations or to suggest any prejudice caused to him.

The Data Protection Commissioner has decided as follows:- In view of the above, the enquiry is closed to the satisfaction of all parties under section 6 of the Data Protection Act 2017 (DPA).
