

This is a summary of the decision of the DPC

The Data Protection Office received an official complaint submitted manually by the Complainant. The complaint was lodged against his neighbour (the Respondent) regarding the installation and use of CCTV cameras. The Complainant alleged that the Respondent's cameras were interfering with his private life. He further stated that he had requested the Respondent to reposition the cameras within the confines of his property, but the Respondent had initially refused.

Subsequently, the Complainant informed this Office that an agreement had been reached with the Respondent concerning the CCTV cameras. He also confirmed that he did not wish to pursue the matter further and requested that the complaint be closed.

The Data Protection Commissioner has decided as follows:-
In view of the above, the enquiry is closed to the satisfaction of all parties under section 6 of the Data Protection Act 2017 (DPA).
