

**This is a summary of the decision of the Commissioner.**

I received a complaint regarding recording of CCTV video of the entrance of shop under Section 11 of the Data Protection Act against respondent. Complainant alleged that one camera records the entrance of his shop and, each and every action that occurs around the shop is being monitored.

My office indicated to respondent that the rules of data protection require that CCTV cameras must be positioned to capture images only within his premise. Moreover, signs must be displayed to notify the public entering his premise of any camera surveillance's system. Respondent was thus informed to take all corrective measures to ensure compliance with the principles of data protection and one camera was requested to be removed.

My office carried out site visits at respondent's place .Consequently , respondent have taken corrective actions and which was verified by my office. Complainant was then informed of the corrective action taken.

I find no commission of any offence under the Data Protection Act.
